GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Type or print clearly all information in black or blue pen. **Please do not use pencil.**
- Elections Officers are available to answer questions and advise on how to complete this form (860-256-2985).
- Candidates who intend to participate in the Citizens' Election Program: Use **SEEC Form CEP 10**.

WHO FILES THIS FORM

A candidate who has filed a Candidate Committee Registration (**SEEC Form 1 and 1A**) and who intends **not** to participate in the Citizens' Election Program (CEP) are to use this form.

A candidate who has filed a Certification of Exemption From Forming a Candidate Committee (**SEEC Form 1 and 1B**) will be deemed "nonparticipating" and is not required to file SEEC Form CEP 11.

Please Note: Because this form is an affidavit, the candidate must initial and sign the appropriate certification under oath before a notary public or Commissioner of Superior Court. A Commissioner of Superior Court is an attorney in good standing admitted to practice law in Connecticut.

*A candidate who intends to participate in the Citizens' Election Program must file a **SEEC Form CEP 10** — Affidavit of Intent to Abide by Expenditure Limits and Other Program Requirements.*

Please Note: This affidavit is **NOT** for use by a candidate who has filed a CEP 10, but who chooses to subsequently withdraw from the Citizens' Election Program. Such candidates must file an Affidavit of Withdrawal from the Citizens' Election Program (**SEEC Form CEP 13**).

WHERE TO FILE THIS FORM

Hand-deliver or mail the completed and signed SEEC Form CEP 11 to: Connecticut State Elections Enforcement Commission, 55 Farmington Ave, Hartford, CT 06105, Attn.: Campaign Finance Disclosure Unit.

WHEN TO FILE THIS FORM

SEEC CEP Form 11 must be completed, signed, and received by the SEEC no later than 4:00 P.M. on the 25th day before the primary date (if applicable), the 40th day before the regular election date, or the 25th day before the special election date, as set forth in subsection (a) of section 9-703, as amended by Public Act 11-48.

COMPLETING THE FORM

Please Note: Whenever *any* information contained on the candidate committee registration (SEEC Form 1 or 1A) changes, the candidate must file an **amended** SEEC FORM 1/1A signed by the candidate, treasurer and deputy treasurer (if applicable) within **10 days** of the date of the change.

SECTION A. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION

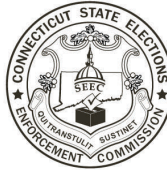
1. **Election Date:** In *mm/dd/yyyy* format, provide the election date for which the candidate is seeking election to a public Office.
2. **Office Sought:** List the name of the public office or position being sought by the candidate as registered with the SEEC Form 1 and 1A.
3. **District Number:** Provide the district number, if applicable, for the public office or position being sought by the candidate.
4. **Candidate Name:** Provide the full name of the candidate (first name, middle initial, last name, suffix) as registered with the SEEC Form 1 and 1A.
5. **Committee Name:** Provide the full name of the committee as registered with the SEEC Form 1 and 1A.

SECTION B. CANDIDATE CERTIFICATION

The candidate must **initial** each line of Section B and sign under oath in front of a notary public or Commissioner of Superior Court. *Notary public or Commissioner of Superior Court must complete their portion of Section B.*

Statewide and General Assembly Candidates

If you are a candidate in any primary or election and elect not to participate in the Citizens' Election Program (and be a "nonparticipating candidate"), this Affidavit must be completed, signed, and received by the State Elections Enforcement Commission no later than 4:00 p.m. on the twenty-fifth (25th) day before the primary date, if applicable, the fortieth (40th) day before the election date, or the twenty-fifth (25th) day before the special election date as set forth in subsection (a) of section 9-703 of the Connecticut General Statutes.
