FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

The Complainant filed this complaint with the Commission pursuant to General Statutes § 9-7b.

After a pro forma investigation of the matter, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:


1. Without making an allegation, the Complainant asks if it is a violation of unspecified statutes to have a town school, town library and town volunteer fire department linked to the Burlington Democratic Town Committee (the "Committee") Facebook page by the "liked by this page" function, which is apparently controlled by the Committee.
2. Without other facts or relevant statutes alleged to have been broken, the Commission makes no finding that the apparent conduct described by the Complainant violates any of the statutes under its jurisdiction. In general, the Commission does not prescribe the accepted content of political speech.

ORDER

The following Order is recommended on the basis of the aforementioned findings:

That no further action be taken.
