NOTICE OF CASES CLOSURE

On March 14, 2023, the Commission initiated an investigation into SEEC File No. 2023-012 based on an alleged failure of Kristen Bevins, Treasurer for the “Jen for the 79th” committee, to file a January 10th Filing on or before January 10, 2023. On June 16, 2023, the Commission initiated an investigation into SEEC File No. 2023-025 based on an alleged failure of Treasurer Kristen Bevins to file an April 10 Filing on or before April 10, 2023. An investigation has revealed that the January 10th Filing was filed with the Commission on February 28, 2023 and the April 10th Filing was filed with the Commission on August 04, 2023. If the \$100 late filing fee has not been paid, the Commission notes that Kristen Bevins is responsible for payment of said late filing fee for each late filing.

The Commission notes that Kristen Bevins has not been previously found in violation of any statute in Title 9 of the General Statutes.

Therefore, for the reasons stated above, on January 21, 2026, at its regularly scheduled meeting, pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 9-7b-42, by a motion adopted on the record, the Commission administratively closed SEEC File Nos. 2023-012 & 2023-025.
