NOTICE OF CASE CLOSURE

At its February 7, 2024, meeting, the Commission, by motion on the record, found it necessary to further investigate the matter in File No. 2024-011. The referral by the Secretary of the State pertained to an individual who arrived at the Town Clerk's office on the day of the January 23, 2024, Bridgeport Special Democratic and complained that her absentee ballot was stolen. She then corrected her statement to indicate that some unknown individual had taken her absentee ballot. The individual subsequently voted in-person at the primary.

The individual complaining of potential absentee ballot fraud did not identify a potential Respondent; who was identified only as "unknown." Further, no witnesses of the incident were provided. The Commission determines there is a lack of information to serve as a predicate for further investigation in this matter and that therefore it declines to commit further resources to the same. For the foregoing reasons, this matter will be administratively closed.

The Commission administratively closes this matter for the reasons stated.
