NOTICE OF CASE CLOSURE

The State Elections Enforcement Commission docketed this complaint based on alleged campaign finance violations within its jurisdiction.

At its February 21, 2024 meeting, after preliminary investigation, the Commission determined on the record that it was not necessary to further investigate this matter pursuant to General Statutes § 9-7b (a) (1).

Due to the facts that the potential named Respondents, are both deceased; that this was a committee from the 2010 election cycle; that the potential violations are premised on a 2015 conversation with one of the decedents; and, that there is information that leads to the inference that the candidate Howard Richman was unaware of the potential fraudulent conduct of his treasurer and deputy treasurer in 2010, the Commission declined to further investigate this matter.

The Commission therefore administratively closes this matter.
