**NOTICE OF CASE CLOSURE**

The State Elections Enforcement Commission docketed this complaint based on alleged elections law violations within its jurisdiction. This complaint pertained to an alleged violation regarding an absentee ballot in connection with the January 23, 2024 Bridgeport Special Democratic Primary.

At its January 22, 2025 meeting, after preliminary investigation, the Commission determined on the record that it was not necessary to further investigate this matter pursuant to General Statutes § 9-7b (a) (1).

The gravamen of this complaint was based on the assertion that an individual on or about January 16, 2024 illegally took possession of an absentee ballot in connection with the January 23, 2024 special election in Bridgeport. The individual in question was identified only as "some Spanish lady." The Complainant in this matter is now deceased.

Based on the limited identification of a potential Respondent and the fact that the complaining witness is now deceased, the Commission determined that it had insufficient information to serve as a predicate for further investigation. Therefore, the Commission determined it was unnecessary to further investigate the alleged violation in this complaint and deemed it appropriate to close this matter.

The Commission therefore administratively closes this matter.
