In the Matter of a Complaint by Alvin Schwapp, Bloomfield

NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

This Complaint was brought pursuant to General Statutes § 9-7b. The Complainant, the Town Manager for Bloomfield, alleges that the Respondent, a Councilman for the Town of Bloomfield, is not a *bona fide* resident of Bloomfield pursuant to General Statutes §9-12 and therefore violated multiple Title 9 General Statutes by participating in Bloomfield elections when he was ineligible to do so.

The Commission has completed its investigation into the allegations of the Complaint. As a result of its investigation and based upon the Commission's established factored analysis for *bona fide* residency, the Commission finds that the evidence does not support the allegations. Therefore, pursuant to General Statutes §9-7a(g)(1)(A)(iii), the Commission determines that *no probable cause* exists concerning the alleged violations.

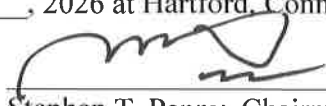
Based on this finding of no probable cause, the Commission dismisses this matter.
